

# BioShield® 75 Use directions

## BIOSHIELD® 75 USE DIRECTIONS

**Commercial and Institutional Applications:** (Businesses, offices, institutions, schools, hospitals, doctor's and dentist's offices, health club facilities, daycare centers, churches, correctional facilities, automobiles, public transportation vehicles, airlines, etc.) For application to small areas, the quart sprayer bottle may be used. For application to larger areas, it is recommended that either an electric sprayer or air pressure sprayer be used to more efficiently apply the Bioshield® 75. Your IndusCo representative can offer recommendations for spray equipment that is best for your application. Make sure that all surfaces are clean and dry. Set the sprayer to a fine mist and apply a light spray to the surfaces to be treated. When treating more porous surfaces, more Bioshield® 75 may be required due to absorption. If the spray runs down the surface, it is being applied too heavily. Allow to dry thoroughly. Be careful not to spray on glass as it may water spot on drying and will be difficult to remove. If glass is accidentally sprayed, quickly wipe off with a dry cloth or paper towel. Examples to spray include floors (both hard surface and carpets), walls, ceilings, furniture, desks, keyboards (should not be sprayed but instead wiped with a cloth or paper towel dampened with Bioshield® 75), doors, door knobs, light switches, bathrooms, kitchens, dining areas, and other high touch points.

**Home Applications:** For most home applications the quart trigger sprayer should be adequate. For larger areas, a pump up garden sprayer may be used. Make sure that all surfaces to be treated are clean and dry. Set the sprayer to a fine mist and apply a light spray to the surfaces to be treated. When treating more porous surfaces, more Bioshield® 75 may be required due to absorption. If the spray runs down the surface it is being applied too heavily. Allow to dry thoroughly. Be careful not to spray on glass as it may water spot on drying and will be difficult to remove. If glass is accidentally sprayed, quickly wipe off with a dry cloth or paper towel. Examples to spray include floors (both hard surface and carpet), walls, ceilings, furniture, curtains, drapes, bathrooms, tubs, showers, shower curtains, commodes, outdoor furniture, decks, insides of shoes, athletic equipment, kitchens, counter tops, automobile interiors, boat interiors, and many more.

**Coverage** will vary with the porosity of the surface to be sprayed and how heavily the product is sprayed, but experience has proven that one gallon of Bioshield® 75 will cover an area of approximately 3000 square feet (including furnishings, floors, walls, and ceilings).

**Drying Time** will depend on temperature, humidity, and air movement. Typically, all surfaces are dry within one hour.

**Applicator Protective Equipment:** Although Bioshield® 75 has a very low level of toxicity, applicators are recommended to wear eye protection (goggles), neoprene gloves, and a safety mask respirator.
